Proposal

Rupert Davis, EF Executive Vice Chair, is authorised to represent EF in discussions as the primary point of contact with lawyers in terms of procuring, scoping, appointing and thereafter utilising legal services: in the first instance for the purposes of drawing up options and rights of first refusal over the Findhorn Foundation assets and any related legal services connected to the proposed community buy out. He is authorised to be the sole point of contact and will report back regularly at EF Board meetings, with regular updates, including incurred fees.
